BEING SALT AND LIGHT IN THE WORLD

"You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lamp stand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven (Matthew 5:13-16)."

Jesus uses the metaphors of salt and light to describe the role of His followers in the world. These verses emphasize that believers are meant to be a positive influence, both preserving goodness and shining as examples of God's character. Salt was used to preserve food and to enhance its taste. To be effective, salt must be in contact with the meat to preserve. As believers, we must be involved where we work and where we live. Similarly, Jesus' followers are called to preserve goodness and righteousness in a world that is often corrupt or lacking in moral values. If believers lose their impact and become worldly, they will be considered useless, like salt that has lost its flavor.

Jesus says His followers should be the light of the world, shining brightly like a city on a hill that cannot be hidden. Just as a lamp is used to illuminate darkness, believers are called to guide others toward Christ through their lives and actions. The light of believers should demonstrate the goodness and love of God to the world. The job description of a Christian is not only to maintain personal holiness, but also to touch the lives of everyone around us with the Gospel of Christ.

In many areas, it seems, we're moving to extremes. People and movements are becoming radical at a disturbingly rapid rate. The "sane middle" seems to be evaporating. Civil debate is almost a thing of the past. Into this intense climate we are sent by Jesus to be agents of His love and peace. We bring with us a message of hope and assurance. While we are often rejected, there seems to be a silent plea, "Please don't stop. In fact, preach it more and preach it louder!" "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven (Matthew 5:16)."


